



Licenses, Testing, Labelling, Safety Regulations, Copyright & Counterfeit Goods Policy

ACM are committed to operating events in a legal manner.

We do not allow stall holders to sell illegal items.

If a stall holder is selling items that have a logo, a brand name or an image that is potentially a trading standards issue, ACM require that the stall holder provides us with the correct documentation to show that the correct licenses have been paid for.

ACM require that all products are labelled in a legal manner, this includes but is not limited to UKCA, CLP, homemade dog treats and children's clothing. ACM will check for compliance.

If a product requires testing, this must be done in the correct way and ACM will ask for evidence that this is being done legally.

If we see an item of concern that we have not been made aware of, we will obtain an image of the item and perform the necessary checks.

We will also ask that the item(s) are removed from sale until the checks have been completed.

If we decide that a trader is not complaint, the trader will not be allowed to attend any event until they can show full compliance.
