



Power Policy

Before booking any event, you must check suitability 1 week in advance, if you have or need to use the following

- Generator
- Electric Hook Up
- Gas (bottles and canisters)
- Electric products that are self-powered (using a power bank, chargeable or solar power)

There are restrictions at certain venues and we need to talk to you to make sure you can trade safely.

Generators

These must be diesel fuel and a silent type. If the noise level exceeds 80 decibels (measured at a 7m distance) you will not be allowed to trade.

Electric hook up

You must obtain approval to trade using electric. We need to know which appliances you are using and the details of the plug type you are using. We may need to know how many volts and amps you need. You will also need to upload your electrical safety certificate and show that all your appliances are PAT tested.

Gas

If you use any gas canisters, you must supply your own fire blanket and dry chemical fire extinguisher. These need to be visible and contained within your stall. A member of the ACM will need to see both of these items before you can light any gas. If your gas canister is over 13kg, it should be secured so it cannot fall over.

We need to see your gas safety certificates AND a fire risk assessment.

Smaller electric items

As well as advising in advance, please advise a member of the ACM team which electrical items you are using on the day so we can conduct a visual check. We do not need to check personal items and these do not need to be PAT tested. If you are using items that we do not consider for personal use, we will ask you to provide a PAT testing certificate before they can be used.

If you book an event without checking first and we are subsequently unable to approve your stall, we will not be able to issue a refund.
